The Temple of St. Sava, Republic Square, The Kalemegdan Park and Belgrade Fortress, new ADA Bridge, Belgrade waterfront, Karadjordjeva street, National Assembly of Serbia, St. Marko's Church, kafana Question mark (oldest restaurant in Belgrade, near the pedestrian zone).

Belgrade is the capital city of Serbia. With a population of about 1.6 million, it sits at the captivating confluence of the rivers Sava and the Danube. The city's most prominent landmark is the Kalemegdan Fortress, overlooking the confluence. Belgrade has a reputation of a lively, never-sleeping city, famed for its nightlife and sociable inhabitants, as well as for countless restaurants and cafés throughout the city, offering different programs every day.
